The context

Coordination Intersectorielle de Lutte contre les IST/VIH/SIDA (CISLS) is a governmental organisation that coordinates all activities to combat AIDS at the national level. It reports to the Nigerian President's cabinet. With about 60 employees, CISLS has six departments and representations in eight regions throughout the Niger.

In addition to coordination tasks, CISLS is conducting a multisectoral programme to fight AIDS funded by the World Bank, and is also the main recipient of funds from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM). CISLS requires support for planning and monitoring, and for improving sectoral advice to the institutions involved, above all as regards cooperation within the framework of GFATM programmes. In this context, CISLS has asked the Centre for International Migration and Development (CIM) to place a programme adviser.

Your tasks

- + Supporting the national coordinator in issues related to programme management
- + Supporting the institutions involved in drawing up the required terms of reference and in implementing and monitoring activities
- + Supporting the efficient drafting of the required progress reports.

Requirements

With a degree in health economics or social science or a similar qualification, your substantial experience includes implementing health programmes. Furthermore, you are familiar with the processes used by GFATM or similar funds. In addition to organisational and analytical skills, you have a good knowledge of data processing. You are flexible, work well in a team, and ideally have experience in an African country. A very good knowledge of both French and English is a must. In addition you have the citizenship of Germany or another EU member country.

Conditions

You will sign a contract with CISLS for an initial period of one or two years, based on local market conditions. You will report to the local employer from both a professional and labour-legislation point of view. CIM will pay a monthly salary top-up and additional social benefits, making up an attractive overall salary.
